 <h4>Pronunciation</h4> <p>It reflects the ability of candidates to produce consonants, vowels, and adding/ deleting sounds. It measures how accurately one is able to produce sounds at the phoneme levels within a word.</p>	 <h4>Fluency</h4> <p>It assesses candidates on how fluent they are while speaking in terms of the rate of speech, pauses, and addition of fillers, through reading and repeating sentences and speaking on the spot on a topic.</p>	 <h4>Grammar</h4> <p>It reflects the ability of candidates to use correct grammar while speaking. Candidates are evaluated on 5 major topics - subject-verb agreement, tenses, word order, prepositions and articles.</p>	 <h4>Listening Comprehension</h4> <p>It assesses candidates on their ability to listen attentively to a conversation or a piece of information in an audio format and recall important pointers and make inferences out of the conversations.</p>

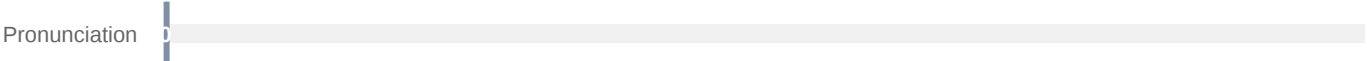
